



Khamzat Khasbulatov **CEO McDonald's Russia** **& President Eastern Division**

In 1988, Khamzat joined McDonald's Russia as the company's first Russian Restaurant manager, responsible for McDonald's Pushkin Square restaurant, the system's busiest restaurant in the World.

In 1990, Khamzat was promoted to Deputy General Director of Moscow McDonald's, in 1997 he became General Director and in 1999 he was named President, McDonald's Russia, followed in 2000 with additional responsibilities for Belarus and in 2002 for Ukraine.

In 2005, Khamzat was promoted to President McDonald's Eastern Europe & CEO McDonald's Russia.

Khamzat graduated from the Moscow Plekhanov University of National Economy in 1977 and worked for the food service division of the Moscow City Government as a restaurant manager. He has received numerous State and Public Awards and is Chairman of Ronald McDonald House Charities (Russia).
